1. Welcome – SCL welcomed members to our last meeting of the year.
2. Focus group - Focus group took place on 02/18/26. Unfortunately, the facilitator had an emergency, and she did not come to the meeting. Our parents took control and discussed the focus group questions and answered them. The questions were written down and turned over to SCL.
 - **1 - What types of programs will bring you to the school?**
Meeting with teachers and staff more than twice a year, Folklorico or more cultural events, food banks and cooking events. Dr. Salcido asked Mr. Dickson for clarification, and he reported parents wanted to learn more about teachers to take them into consideration for event planning.

 - **3 - If you can come up with your own activity, will you help plan it?**
Yes. A parent recommended a quiz show-like event such as "who's smarter than a 5th grader" between parents and students. Mr. Dickson reported that a quiz show will be good as students would like to show off their knowledge in front of their parents.
 - **4 - Will family fun nights (karaoke, singing, dancing, painting), bring you to the school ?**
Yes. Parents recommended trivia nights, loteria nights. An interactive night for parents and students. SCL recommended that when we have this night, we can ask PTA to sponsor it and make it a night of prizes and ask PTA to buy juice and snacks to get parents to come without having to spend money. Dr. Salcido reported that if we do this, she recommends covered cups to keep from making messes of spilling juice on the floor. Mr. Dickson recommended buying Kool-Aid pouches to prevent spills. SCL reported that this would depend on the PTA can buy this for the event.

- **5 - Will your student receiving a prize make you want to participate?**

Yes. Parents felt strong that students need to truly earn the prizes. SCL recommended that we can offer these prizes to students with proficiency and above proficiency on their upcoming tests. Mrs. Gomez stated that she would provide information on the students who do well.
